#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- ➔ Online registration is mandatory.
- ➔ Students of classes 9, 10, 11 and 12 are eligible to participate.
- It is a team contest. Each team must have 3 participants. One school can register a maximum of 3 teams.
- Registrations will be accepted until 02 November 2022 (11:59 p.m.). Prelims competition will be conducted in English via Zoom only.
- Once registered, participants cannot be changed or replaced without prior notice and written approval from the hosting committee.
- A technical meeting will be set up prior to the start of the events and the same will be intimated to the participants to get their queries clarified.
- The Prelims will be held online only. Semi-Finals and Finals will be held offline in Chennai. (Venue will be shared later.)
- ➔ We follow the WSDC format of debate.
- Detailed rules and regulations will be shared upon registration.
- First-prize winners of the debate competition must make their own travel and accommodation arrangements if they wish to attend the GFH 2022 award ceremony to be held in Chennai on 18 November 2022 (tentative).
- The decision of the judges stands final.
